OVERCOMING OBSTACLES

There are many closed churches of communities all over Northern India and each is a mix testimony to the fact that a group of people gave up their struggle to maintain a gospel testimony. We dare not condemn them, but what happened to them reminds at that Victory in God's Service is possible only as a result of uphill work against all kinds of opposition. Our personal experience has doubtless convinced us the various forms of spiritual battles are often fought against heavy odds.

Even before Nehemiah started building the walls of Jerusalem. The enemies of God's cause reacted to His coming (Neh. 2:10). Now we see how various forms of opposition. To the Lord's work assumed; and the means by which Nehemiah overcome it.

A. About Godly Man Nehemiah

1. A Man Prayer:

Nehemiah was a man of prayer. Someone would call him. Knee-miah. A man of prayer is always a man of power. He acted with praying and he himself spent and practiced the presence of God. By his diligence, vigilance and prudence he overcame all his enemies plan and projects. Nehemiah means "God has comforted". He Revived worship introduced law and order.

Nehemiah the Jews speaks as one of the greatest men of their nation. His concern for his country, manifested by such unequivocal marks, entitles him to the character of the first patriot that ever lived. In the course of the Divine providence, he was captive in Babylon, but there his excellences were so apparent, that he was chosen by the Persian King to fill an office the most respectable and the much confidential in the whole court. He sought the peace of Jerusalem; he prayed to God for it, and was willing to scarifies wealth, ease, and safety and wen the life itself. And God who saw the desire of his heart, and know the excellence with which he had endowed him, granted his request, and

gave him the high honour & restoring the desolated city of his ancestors, and pure worship of their God.

2. An Outstanding Leader:

Nehemiah showed his leadership by enquired about the welfare of the Jews and about Jerusalem as some people arrived from Judah. This really touches the hearts of the people. Nehemiah had shown his leadership by identifying himself with people (Neh 2: 17, 18). He was the Governor and could have issued authoritative Commands; but he stood among than as one of them. Nehemiah passed on to leaders of Jews two inspiring facts. He gave them his personal testimony telling them that God's good hand was upon him in the project. He added how King Artaxerxes had sponsored his coming and given him authority.

3. A Man Who Passes His Vision on Producing Leaders:

Nehemiah was always a man of Action. He was able to solve problems troubles and ability to find solution for it. He was unselfish in work and his efforts to improve the people of Jerusalem. Most of his action are filled with courage were to help a common man. He was a complete master of motivation and organization.

On return to his people and the land he was able to spoke the officials, priests and Nobles because he felt the responsibility to motivate and lift up the spirit of the people. Therefore, he said, "Let us rebuild the wall of Jerusalem". On his exhortation majority people have both men and woman responded very happily. (Neh 2: 16)

Thus he passes his vision to the people to rebuild the walls.

4. A Man Steady and Uncompromising:

The enemies of Nehemiah asked him to leave his work and asked him to be in a village (Neh.6:1-3). This compromise initiated by his enemies Sanballat and Geshem. Through their foul play, they want to dispose Nehemiah once for all from the land. Their actual purpose was to kill him. Knowing their malicious intention Nehemiah told them that he was too busy working for the Lord. But they tried more than four occasions to trick him to leave the work, but he was uncompromised.

But Nehemiah said, "they were planning to harm me". He clearly and distinctly knows the enemies(Neh 6: 2). He was clear that the enemies would change their strategy to kill him at any cost. But the Lord was with him. Satan always behind to every destructive attach trying to find out new Strategies.

5. A Man Who Does Not Run Away, Persons from Problems:

When Nehemiah life was in danger, he said, "Should a man like me flee, and could one such as I go into the temple to save his life? I will not go in" (Neh 6: 11). More than the problems which Nehemiah had to face but there was God who can solve everything on his behalf. He did not run away or troubled to face it, but he was bold enough. Since the Lord would fight on His behalf. He was bold enough because the Lord's hand was upon him.

B. The Work Planned and Ruin Places are Inspected.

The discouraging report on condition in Jerusalem (Neh1: 3) had brought Nehemiah to the city from his positions as a cup bearer to the Persian monarch. He was not satisfied with hear say evidence; he wanted to see for himself exactly what he was facing as newly appointed governor (5: 14) of Judah. Upon his arrival, he did not speak even to the elders of the city about his intention to rebuild the walls. Taking few trusted companions, he made a secret preliminary inspection of the ruins by moon light, his companions going on foot (2: 12) to avoid attracting attention.

Although the Lord led Nehemiah to undertake the reconstruction of Jerusalem walls, he could not do the job by single handed. He needed helpers. And in order to get helpers, he would have to convince the elders of the city (2:16), in whom he had not yet confided. As he knew the extent of the work and resacrees available for the task, Nehemiah did not care to go to the elders for help until he knew exactly what was involved and had carefully prepared a recommendation.

He also stated how king Artaxerxes had sponsored his coming and given him authority. Nehemiah appealed to all groups (2:16,17) rather than a small elique. The work of God often fails because it is left to an "exclusive" group of Christians.

Nehemiah's approach led his followers to do exactly what he wanted them to do exactly what he wanted than to do. They re-echoed his invitation, and said, "let us rise up and build." His desire had now become the desire of the people.

C. The Work Assigned to Persons:

No one person can do all God's work. Various groups of Jews took their places on different parts of the wall, many of them on the portion nears to their own houses.

The priest,repaired the post of the wall of opposite the temple including the sheep gate (3:1). The men of Jericho built on the side of Jerusalem that faced their city. Each group took care of its special responsibility. The nobles of Tekoacity (people); The VIPs were just too important to get involved in the menial work of building the wall. What did Nehemiah think they were? Stone masons? Fortunately, the Common people of Tekoa was not influenced by their fastidious nobles. They worked so hard that they not only finished their own stint but took on a second section of the wall (3: 27). All kinds of people served on the walls, even goldsmith and pharmacists (Neh 3: 12).

D. The Work Opposed: -

<u>1. Opposition Through – Ridicule VS</u> Work:

Even before the reconstruction of the city wall get underway, the project was greeted by the Ridicule of the Jew's enemies. Sanballat, Tobiah and Geshem sneered at the Jew's intentions and accused them falsely of taking a first step toward rebellion (Neh 2: 19). The issue of rebellion war raised more in ridicule than in earnest. The Jew's had been so passive and weak that to accuse than of rebellion was a joke.

Nehemiah was not greatly distressed by the ridicule of Sanballat and his Companies. He considered the source of the division and did not let it upset him. His confidence was in God and not his own ability. He accepted the fact that his people were different form the Samaritans and other people of the land. These men hated the Governor for rebuffing them. Nehemiah confidently looked to God for help, he could well afford to ignore the help of those who did not believe in God.

Once the work of building got actively under way, Sanballat and his companions began to use in earnest a weapon that has defeated many a noble purpose in every generation. They laughed at the Jews, and openly mocked them, making light of their hard work.

Sanballat accused Jews of trying to finish the city walls in a day's time and of building with rubble from the old wall (Neh 4:2). Tobiah added that if a Jackal (fox) climbed the wall in his quest for food, the whole thing would come tumbling down.

Men hate to be ridiculed and Nehemiah was no exception. Nehemiah prayed, "Hear, oh our God, because we are despised. This prayer is first of all, a request that God will listen to the enemies'taunts.

Nehemiah 4:6; "So built we the wall for the people had the mind to work."

Apparently, Nehemiah's prayer encouraged the people, for they began their work with a will. And it was not long until the wall was built to half its full height all around the city.

2. Opposition Through Discouragementvs Faith: - Nehemiah 4: 8

One of the greatest obstacles to God's work is the discouragement that overcomes individual or organization. The people of Judah complained that, "Due to the weariness of the workers and the large amount of rubbish needing to be removed, they were not able to continue building the wall." They had heard rumors about the plots of their adversaries to take them by surprise and stop their work.

Nehemiah beat off discouragement by calling on his people to trust in the Lord (Neh. 4:14) If we think too much about the enemy, our discouragement will be intensified. Only if we trust in the power of our omnipotent God, we can overcome discouragement. Our Lord is equal to any occasion.

3. Opposition Through Danger vs Watchfulness:- Nehemiah 4: 7 - 9

The enemies began their opposition with ridicule and mockery. Then they tried to discourage the Jews. But when all their indirect methods failed to halt the work, they planned a full - scale attack. The devil doesn't like an open fight, that underhand methods are much more likely to be successful. In the case of these Jews, the gathering of the enemy forces was too late. Nehemiah had shown much wisdom in laying her plans carefully and at first Secretly.

At every turn Nehemiah and his colleagues resorted to prayer and looked God for strength and guidance (Neh 2:20, 4:4, 5, 9.14, 20). God was their refuge and strength their present help in trouble (Ps. 46:1). The Jews had a counter intelligence service at work. The Lord know the thoughts of Sanballat and his colleagues, their

plans movements did not take Him by Surprise. Since the Jews trusted in God. He was able to lead them to do the right thing at the right time to avoid every thrust of the enemy. Nehemiah and the Jews prayed for deliverance from the power of armed force and God Showed them how to watch as well pray. Nehemiah met the threat of military action by keeping his people on the alert (Neh 4: 17). Every worker was ready to fight at time because God was with them.

E. The One Who Praying for Himself & at the End:

After the Completion of his work Nehemiah prayed, "Remember me, o my God for good" (Neh 13: 31). Under God's direction, Nehemiah had accomplished and completed a tremendous work under God's accomplished and completed a tremendous work under God's direction. And finally, he wanted that God had to remember him and blessed by Him. Nehemiah never be a selfish under any circumstances but wanted to be in the hands of God at anytime and anywhere.

F. Let Us Rise Up and Let Us Build:

It is normal for God's people to face obstacles in doing His work. The Devil is responsible for the ridicule, the

discouragement, and the active opposition that God's children encounteras they serve the Lord is and around the world.

They are ready to put their shoulders under more burdens, sacrifice their comforts and conveniences, work, overtime and put their trust in God rather than in their own ingenuity, they may be assured of victory. God's enemies gird themselves for a fresh attack whenever God's people undertake something worthwhile.

We can overcome oppositions if we are ready to gird on a Sword and take up a trowel. On the one hand we must meet the attacks of the enemy; on the other we must build constructively and cooperatively for Christ and His kingdom.

But how many are willing to work in the service of God, from rising of the Sun until the stars appear?

"You have not yet resisted to bloodshed, striving against sin" (Hebrews 12:4).

Similarly, many people fall due to sins like anger, jealousy, disobedience, hatred, irritability, lack of brotherly love, and dishonesty than those who fall due to major sins like

murder, adultery, alcoholism, idol worship, witchcraft, and homosexuality.

Even though Jesus Christ was hungry after fasting for 40 days, when He was tempted by the devil, He did not yield to the desires of the flesh. But Esau, weary and hungry, undervalued and sold his birthright for a mere meal.
