



It may be true if we read His word, it may point out mistakes and where we are lacking in (Day to day life). In the history of the Church, many people had been martyred just for the sake of the word of God.

In the Book of James, it talks about the "PRACTISE OF THE WORD".

Most scholars believe that this letter was written by James, the younger brother of Jesus (Gal. 1:19). James was a leader in the Church in Jerusalem (Gal. 2:9). This letter could not have been written later than 62 A.D. because in that year James was put to death.

In James' time many would say, "We are saved by Faith only and not by Good works, there is no need to do good works." It was mainly to correct them, James wrote this letter.

In James 1: 21-27, he talks about how to PRACTISE HIS WORD.

- I. GOD'S WORD PLANTED IN US (Verse:21-22).
- II. GOD'S WORD COMPARED TO A MIRROR (Verse:23-25).
- III. GOD'S WORD IN CONTROLLING TONGUE (Verse:26-27).

Now we see how the word of God is rooted in our life.

# I. GOD'S WORD PLANTED IN US (James 1:21,22)

God created us through the word of Truth. The word of Truth can mean Jesus Christ Himself (John 1:1-3), or it can mean the Gospel of Christ (I Peter 1:23). The word of God is planted.

We have to believe His word.
We have to accept His word.
We have to nurture His word.
We have to read His word.

Being born again, not of corruptible seed, but of incorruptible, **BY THE WORD OF GOD**, which liveth and abideth forever (I Peter 1:23). If God's word grows within us, it will save us. If we allow God's word in us to die, it will not save us (Mark 4:14-20).

James wrote, everyone should be quite to listen. But it is not enough only to LISTEN TO GOD'S WORD. We must OBEY GOD'S WORD. We are not saved by listening; we are saved by believing. TRUE BELIEVING ALWAYS INCLUDES OBEDIENCE (James 2:14-17). Many people hear God's word and say "WHAT A PLEASING WORD", but even though they read God's word and like it, if the don't obey it, it will do them NO GOOD. But truly, they will be judged by it. Many people don't obey God's word, do not have true faith, and they only deceive themselves.

# D. L. MOODY SAID "THE BIBLE IS THE BIBLE'S BEST COMMENTARY."

When we keep reading the Bible, the VOICE OF THE LORD COMES TO OUR HEART TO PLANT THE WORD. The voice of the Lord will make our Heart and Spirit skip like a young deer (Psalm 29:6-7).

If we need to spend quality time with God's word, it is necessary that we withdraw ourselves from certain so- called sinless or harmless pastimes.

Apostle Paul's admonition to Timothy highlights some important principles. In 2 Timothy 3:16-17, "All Scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, righteousness, that the man of God may be **COMPLETE** and **THOROUGHLY** equipped for **EVERY** good work. Here we can see four things as the benefits of God's word:

- A. Doctrine.
- B. Reproof.
- C. Correction.
- D. Instruction.

#### A.Doctrine:

As we are living under the New Covenant, we have to learn doctrine from the New Testament Epistles both for our personal lives and Church life.

#### B. Reproof:

From the Old Testament history one can learn the lessons of reproof, while writing to the Corinthian Church believers, "All these things happened to them for example: and they were written for our admonitions, on whom the ends of the world are come" (I Cor. 10:11).

#### C. Correction:

It is very prominent in the Gospels that Jesus came very hard and heavy upon the unscriptural traditions and wrong practices of the religion of His day. This angered the Jewish leaders, and that led to His crucifixion.

#### **D. Instructions:**

The instruction for righteousness are so important from the books like Proverbs and

Ecclesiastes. These books are rich with principles for practical life. If we are not obedient to God and His word constantly, instantly and continuously, there will come a point where God will have to bypass us (This is what happened to king Saul. I Samuel 15:22-28).

# II. GOD' WORD COMPARED TO A MIRROR (James 1:23-25)

A good mirror shows defects, like wrinkles, depressions and the increasing boldness. If anyone forgets this and walk out of his dressing room, he would falsely believe that he is the most handsome person in the world. But if he says that he would remember what he has seen, he will be level headed. That is the Bible, it does not lie, it mirrors us as we are along with our defects. The Bible exposes our faults and stops there.

When we look in a mirror, we see our true face or self, and that is we see our sinful nature. God's word is like a mirror, shows our sin. But if we only listen to His word without heeding it, we will be like a man who looks into a mirror, **SEES HIS SIN**; and then immediately turns away and forgets about it.

Let us not turn away from the "MIRROR" quickly. We will need to get rid of the SIN that we see in the mirror. We see many people are religious person, but instantly they are religiously outside only. Inwardly there is much evil in their hearts; therefore, when they speak, evil comes out in their words but no GOD'S WORD.

# III. GOD' WORD IN CONTROLLING TONGUES (James 1:26)

Among Christians, the commonest and most destructive sins are sins of tongue. Buddha said, "Tongue is a sharp knife, and it will kill a person without shedding blood."

- a. One can control a big Horse with a small bit. Our tongue is like a bit. If we control our tongue, we could then control our whole body (James 3:3).
- b. Our tongue is also like a rudder of a large ship. A rudder, is a very small thing attached to the back of a ship, by which the ship can be steered. In the same way, our tongue is a very small member of our body, but it has a big effect (James 3:4).
- c. Out tongue is like a small spark of fire or like a match. Such a small thing can set a huge forest on fire (James 3:5).

Therefore, one small word of slander can split a church and a family and brings dishonor to God. One small word of false teaching can cause many to go astray.

Tongue itself is like a fire. Satan uses our tongue more than any other members of our members.

# "OUR TONGUE IS SET ON FIRE. BY HELL, SATAN SETS OUR TONGUE ON FIRE"

If we do not control our tongue, our tongue will corrupt our whole person of life on fire, and it will lead us to destruction. Our tongue is a restless evil, it always looks for an occasion to speak evil and is also full of deadly poison. Many people have double- tongued. In prayer meetings they praise God with sweet words, but then they go out later and speak evil of their

brother and sister. **OUT OF THE SAME**MOUTH COME PRAISE AND CURSING.

My beloved, don't use your tongue to criticize and Judge each other (James 3:6). Jesus himself taught how important our words are to God. Jesus said, "I tell your men will have to give account on the day of Judgement for every coreless word they have spoken. For by your words, you will be acquitted and by your words you will be condemned" (Mathew 12:36-37).

Again, my beloved, I have to point out "WHEN YOU PRAY YOU SPEAK TO GOD

BUT ONLY WHEN YOU READ HIS WORD, i.e. THE BIBLE REGULARLY, GOD SPEAKS TO YOU."

Are you ready to speak to HIM? Which may lead you to achieve and accomplish some thing great for the extension of His kingdom by winning souls in the year 2025.

Let us lead a pure life and loving heart which is a proof of our True Living.

### WORLD NEWS

- 1. D. Gukesh of India emerged victorious in the Chess Championship that began on November 25th in Singapore, defeating reigning champion Ding Liren of China to claim the World Chess Champion title. He was honoured with a flower garland and awarded a cash prize of ₹11 crore. This achievement has brought great pride to India.
- 2. The Ministry of External Affairs announced that 75 Indian nationals were safely rescued from Syria amidst tense situations.
- 3. Chinese President Xi Jinping directed officials to implement development projects that prioritize national security and stability along the border areas.
- 4. Russian military commander Igor Kirillov was assassinated in a scooter bomb attack. An Uzbek youth has been arrested in connection with the incident.
- 5. Recent Israeli attacks in the Gaza region have claimed 38 lives, with 203 people injured. Since the conflict began on October 7, 2023, approximately 45,097 people have lost their lives.
- 6. German luxury carmaker Audi has decided to raise its prices in India by up to 3%, effective January 1.
