JUDGEMENT (John 5 : 24-29)

Every action has it own reaction, and that every good or bad deed has its own impacts and results. Please note every good or bad deeds of human beings have its present and future judgement effects.

"...It is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgement" (Heb. 9:27). The Bible represents God has ruler of Men, law giver, and final Judge (James 4:12). Sometimes God is the Judge (Heb. 12:23), Sometimes Christ (2 Tim. 4:8). God will judge the world in righteousness by that man whom he hath ordained (Acts 17:31). The judgement seat of God (Rom. 14: 10) and the judgment seat of Christ (2 Cor. 5:10) are interchangeable terms.

Now we can see

- I. It is God's Judgment
- II. God's Judgment is Righteous One
- III. God's Final Judgment

I. It is God's Judgment

The basic principle of judgment is justice of God (Genesis 18:25; Rom. 3:3,4). In the Old Testament if anyone commit sin, he would be judged by God with instantaneous punishment. No one can escape from God's punishment and that the Lord would expect "Repent from Sin" and "Restitution for Sin"

"Live in sin is to be live in death; and those who live and die thus shall die eternally."

"Death is the county whose every Christless should live, the man who know not God lives a dying life or living death"

A. Judgment of God for Adam and Eve's Sin

In the Old Testament, it is important to note if any one who disobeyed God and His laws, he would be expelled from the presence of God. God said, "It is not good that the man should be alone (Gen. 2:18), therefore He made a woman (Gen. 2: 22) to be a help to him. At the inducement of the serpent, the woman (Eve) persuaded Adam to eat from the fruit of the tree which he had been commanded by God NOT to touch.

As a result, Adam and Eve were expelled from the garden of Eden (Gen. 3:23, 24). It is evident until this time Adam had a close communion and conversation with God.

It is the judgment of God were Adam and Eve were punished by expulsion from the garden and subjection to the future, lot of obtaining his livelihood in painful toil and in the sweat of his face, since the ground to which now he would return at his death, was cursed and bring forth thorn bushed and thistles. Because of one man (Adam) sin, we were all made sinners.

B. Judgment of God for King David's Sin

When King David looked at the beautiful woman, a sinful desire entered in his mind. He

allowed his mind in what he saw knowing the fact that Bathsheba the daughter of Eliam, the wife of Uriah the Hittite (2 Samuel 11:11). Uriah refused to sleep with Bathsheba because he preferred duty before pleasure. He was a leading warrior one among the 37 (2 Samuel 23:39). David rewarded Uriah with murder. David covered his sin of conspiracy, deceived the nation and thus committed sin against God because King David not rip temptation in the bud.

I have to point out if anyone commits sin it completely displeases God. The first consequence of sin, soon after it was predicted. The Lord God struck the son of Bathsheba bore to David with a sickness. On the 7th day, the child died due to sickness and that was the judgment of God for his deed.

The second consequence in 2nd Samuel Chapter 3; Absalom, the son of David had a beautiful sister Tamar. Amnon the son of David loved Tamar very much, but it was a physical and incestuous love. Because of the advice of wicked friend Jonadab, Amon spoiled Tamar wantonly.

This is the judgment of God for king David's sin. Please remember even though God had forgiveness for the sins of David for what he had committed but the impact of sin would go all through his life.

II. God's Judgment is Righteous One

The dead shall hear His voice

3 Kinds of death

- 1. Natural Death: Separation of body and soul.
- 2. Spiritual Death: Separation of God and soul.
- 3. Eternal Death: Separation of body and soul from God in the other world.

Natural Life: Union of the soul and body

Spiritual Life: Union of God and soul by faith and love.

Eternal Life: Communion of body and soul with God by holiness in the realm of bliss.

A. The Hour is Coming

When all those sleep in the dust shall awake at the voice of the Son of Man and come to JUDGMENT for, HE GIVETH LIFE TO THE DEAD (John 5:27,28,29).

B. The Hour is Coming

Those who die on NATURAL DEATH shall hear THE VOICE OF THE SIN OF GOD. It is likely that our Lord had not as yet raise any from the DEAD.

Here he refers to those whom **He intend to** raise.

C. The Hour is Coming

Many who are dead in trespass and SIN shall hear the voice of the Son of God, believe and receive spiritual life through Him.

DO NOT MARVELATTHIS: "Because I am a man for greater things, then these shall be done by me. He who addresses you, though

disguises under a form of Man, shall appear in the great day to be the **JUDGE of Quick and DEAD**.

By the Almighty power, He shall raise all the dead. By His unerring wisdom and Justice shall adjudge the wicked to Hell and the righteous to Heaven.

"Who knowing the judgment of God; that they which commit such things are worthy of death not only do the same but have pleasure in them..." (Romans 1:32).

"And I heard another out of the altar say, Even so, Lord God Almighty, true and righteous are thy judgments" (Revelation 16:7).

"And I saw heaven opened, and behold a white horse; and he that sat upon him was called Faithful and True, and in righteousness he doth judge and make war" (Revelation 19:11).

III. God's Final Judgment

As God the son, Jesus Christ will be the judge of the final Judgement (John 5:22). All unbelievers, thieves, murders, liars, backbiters, adulterers and slanderers will stand before Jesus Christ at the great white throne, and they will be punished according to the works they have done.

The Bible says that unbelievers are currently storing up wrath against themselves (Romans 2:6) and that God will repay each person according to what they have done

(Believers will be judged separately at the judgment seat of Christ, a judgment of examination and reward).

At the great white throne, the fate of the unsaved will be in the hands of Omniscient God who will judge everyone according to his or her soul's condition and the works done in the body.

For now, our fate is in our hands. Then end of soul's journey will either be in eternal Heaven or in an eternal hell (Matthew 25: 46). We must choose our destination by either accepting or rejecting the sacrifice of Christ on our behalf. We make that choice before our physical lives come to an end. After we die, we no longer have a choice.

Finally, my beloved, "Everyone who has ever lived will face God someday."

"Nothing in all creation is hidden from God's sight. Everything is uncovered and laid bare before the eyes of Him to whom we must give account" (Hebrews 4:13).

Please note my beloved, "The last judgment will occur after resurrection of the dead, and our "mortal body" will come to life again and at the last judgement, Christ will come in His glory, and all the angels with him, and in his presence the truth of each one's deeds will be laid bare"

- 1. An Indian-origin youth named Trapit Bansal, who completed his undergraduate studies at IIT Kanpur and worked as a researcher at OpenAI, has been offered a job at Meta with an annual salary of Rs. 853 crore (100 million USD).

Please pray that the 281 audio devices given to the translator will be distributed to the right people, and that those who receive them will use them daily and grow in the Lord.
