WORD OF TRUTH
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JESUS IS THE LIGHT IN 2026 (Matthew 5:13-16)



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If any father or mother would ask their son and daughter, "what is their ambition in life?" They would say that they want to become a Doctor, an Engineer, or teacher in future. Even God created little insect with a purpose of Aim in life. If anyone goes to Hill stations like the Nilgiris or Kodaikanal, he or she could see lots of varieties and different colors of Roses which would captivate our eyes and mind. But if you note at the back of Rose petals, you could see a small insect green in colour. During winter time Ants would take these insects on the stage under the Earth where ants would get liquid from these and eat live during the chill season. Scientists say these are called "Ant Cows". Please note God created every a very small insect with an aim or purpose.

But what about Men and Women? ***"You are the Light of this World"* Matt. 5:14.**

***"I am the light of the world: he that followeth me shall not walk in darkness, but shall have the light of life"* (Jn. 8:12)**

***"As long as I am in the world, I am the light of the world"* (Jn. 9:5)**

At the time of Passover festival (it is the eight days Jewish holiday) where Josephus says, "The Jewish people as families joined hands together and dance around the "Lights" to celebrate Passover festival and how God redeemed them from the hands of Pharaoh. In Jesus times at the time of Passover festival of LIGHT, Jesus visited the Synagogue and told the Jewish people that He (Jesus) is the Light of the world which all people of the nations should follow Him. Therefore, YOU ARE THE LIGHT OF THIS WORLD.

Now we see what are the Functions of Light

- i) Light is different from darkness.
- ii) Light overcomes the darkness of sin.
- iii) Light's Position is High.
- iv) Light wins people for Jesus.

I. Light is Different from Darkness **(Gen. 1:13-18)**

In Genesis 1:18, To rule over the day and over the night and to divide the light from darkness and God saw that it was good. **Our behavior must be different from the behavior of other people**, just as the light which is different from darkness. This is the reason God divided the light from darkness. People must be able to see the light in us. We have to show different walks of light. Remember WE ARE THE 5TH GOSPEL SO THAT PEOPLE MAY READ OUR LIFE.

Once a preacher showing a gospel film on the street about the Life of Sadhu Sundar Singh. As soon as the film is over, a person from Hindu background came and shouted at the preacher. He said, "Please stop showing the film and do not talk about Jesus anymore." The preacher humbly asked the reason for it. He replied, "I am working in an office where one of my friend Mr. Thomas also work over there. I come to the office everyday only after 10:30 in the morning whereas Mr. Thomas come to the office after 11.00 am. I know that I should not steal any office materials, such as pencil, paper and pen, but I steal it. Mr. Thomas steal more than me. But I see only one difference. If Friday comes, I take my wife, my children along with

me to the temple where as Mr. Thomas goes to Church along with his family members by taking Hymnal book and Bible with them. Do you say and profess you are Christian? In what way you are differ from me? You do not show Jesus in you.”

This is the heart beat of India that they want to see the light of Jesus in our life. If any person read Mahatma Gandhiji Book, “My Experiment with Truth”, he has stated, “If all Christians in India would follow Jesus’ teachings in an outside of life, then there will be no more Hindus in India.” My Friend, note, because of our inconsistent Christian life we betray Jesus in all areas and aspects of our life. Let us leave darkness in our life in 2026 and lead a (Different) life of Light.

II. Light Overcomes the Darkness of Sin

“And the light shineth in darkness; and the darkness comprehended it not” (Jn. 1:5).

“...that God is light, and in him is no darkness at all” (1 Jn. 1:5)

“...light is come into the world, and men loved darkness rather than light, because their deeds were evil. For every one that doeth evil hateth the light, neither cometh to the light, lest his deeds should be reprov'd. But he that doeth truth cometh to the light, that his deeds may be made manifest, that they are wrought in God” (Jn. 3:19-21).

From the above Biblical verses it is clear to hide understand a child of God should not hind any secret sin in his/her life. A Sunday school teacher once said about Vijayan’s heart. Before the light of Jesus is not penetrate into his heart, there are lots of snakes, lizards and other unwanted things in his heart. But when the light

of Jesus deeply penetrated into the heart of Vijayan, all these unwanted insects flew away because it cannot stand before the light of Jesus. As Josephus would say that King David made a cover-up plan for his sin that he has committed, he deliberately committed sin with Bathsheba and he did not nip temptation in the bud. He fell into sin. It always displeases God when we sin.

Please note: 1) He put the god of lust before the God of heaven. 2) He coveted his neighbour’s wife. 3) He committed adultery. 4) He indirectly murdered Uriah.

Remember my friend; the impact of sin that were continuing all through his life although God had forgiven his sin. Please read 2 Samuel Chapter 13. Amon spoiled Tamar’s life under the guidance of his friend (bad) Jonadab. But king David kept mute silence. King David’ son Absolom led a life of adultery with many women but no action was taken by King David because he himself committed sin. It is a warning for everyone do not live in the darkness of sin. If you hide, it will come out one day.

In Judges Chapter 14, we see the darkness sin of Samson. 1) He fell for the woman at Timnah. 2) He went into a harlot at Gaza and Delilah was 3rd woman who dallied or played around him. Sin blinds people. It blinds them of their duty to God also blinds us of our duty to our fellowmen. When we sin, we not only loose our power. We also lose our peace. The pitiful thing about Samson was he did not know that his strength was gone. “Samson did not know that the Lord had departed from him” (Judges 16:20). Beloved, give up all your sins of darkness and let the light of Jesus cover you in this New Year 2026.

III. Light's Position is High

“Neither do men light a candle, and put it under a bushel, but on a candlestick; and it giveth light unto all that are in the house. Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven” (Matt. 5:15-16).

Any child of God is called to lead a life of high so that the life of light which leads many people unto the Lord Jesus.

“If ye then be risen with Christ, seek those things which are above, where Christ sitteth on the right hand of God. 2 Set your affection on things above, not on things on the earth. 3 For ye are dead, and your life is hid with Christ in God” (Col. 3:1-3)

Dr. Billy Graham used to say often in his message about swine (pig) in Tamil “Pandrigal”. It will not look above in its total life. It always looks on the earth where it would go and lie down on ditches and enjoying its bad smell. Even if someone calls it, no response from its end. As long as the swine's lives in earth, it won't look abuse and won't enjoy the world nature, its color so on. But it enjoys only the dirty things on the earth. And there will come a point in its life where a person tied its four legs with a rope and turn upside down. The pig would feel that it misses lots of good things in life. But SWORD CAME ITS NECK. There are so many people of Christians as long as they live in earth, they always want to enjoy the pitfall of sins. They won't look above but on the earth. A God's child is to called to live on the things above. If they look on the earth with sinful lust and they die on it.

St. Paul says since you have been, “raised with Christ” to seek heavenly things, setting

their minds above earthly concerns because their true life hidden with Christ in God now, signifying a new spiritual reality and a call to live accordingly, not according to the old life. Therefore, focus your attention, desires and priorities on spiritual realities, not worldly, temporary things. Our true eternal life is secure and protected in Christ who is with God.

2026, call to action is, it's not just a statement but a command to live out this new identity through spiritual discipline and a heavenly perspective. In the new year 2026, put to death earthly vices like immorality, anger, slander and greed. Let us cloth ourselves with virtues such as compassion, kindness, humility and above all LOVE, and let the peace of God rule in our hearts and let the word of Christ dwell in us richly.

IV. Light Wins People for Jesus

If anyone goes to Chennai harbour near Royapuram, we would see a light house where a ship not to go astray but the Light House's light leads the ship in a proper way to reach the harbour. Wherever a child of Jesus is there, automatically, He would draw people near to him which help him to win souls for the extension of His kingdom. Fulfilling a Great Commission in Mathew 28:19-20 ***“...Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, Son and of the Holy Spirit”.***

“Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you; and, I am with you always even unto the end of the world. Amen”

Winning souls for Christ is considered a vital part of Christian life, rooted in God's love for humanity.

The core concept is:

A. Evangelism: Sharing the message of Jesus' death, resurrection and offer of forgiveness and eternal life.

B. Making disciples: The broader goal of making followers, who then make more followers (Mt. 28:19).

C. Biblical Mandate: Jesus commanded his followers to go into all the world and preach the Gospel (Mk. 16:15)

Practical Method:

- Prayer- praying for lost souls and for boldness to share faith.
- Testimony- sharing personal experiences of what God has done.
- Good works- living a godly life that reflects Christ love (love your enemies and serve the needy)

Proclamation- telling the people the good news directly, relying on the power of the Gospel message itself.

Motivation and Beliefs:

- God desires all people to be saved (II Pet 3:9).
- It is a divine love.
- God and angels rejoice over a repent sinner (Lk 15:7). It is a heavenly joy.
- The Bible states, "he that winneth souls is wise" (Pro 11:3). It is a wisdom.
- Jesus' children are called to warn the wicked, lest their blood be on their hands (Eze. 3:18). It's an accountability.
- While Christians labor, it is ultimately God's spirit who brings Salvation. It's a supernatural work.

Dr. Stanly Jones, a Chinese Missionary wrote an interesting thing in his biography. When he was working in China as a missionary and a doctor where he was preparing a medicine at his room, he heard a noise that someone knocking at the door. He opened the door and had seen a little dog who broken its leg, crying and asking for help to get speedy recovery. Dr. Stanly Jones looked at the dog with pity and took complete care on it. After few days, the little dog was completely healed and fled away from him.

Dr. Jones became so sad. But after few days he heard the noise that someone knocking at the door. Dr. Jones opened the door where he had seen the same little dog dancing with its tail pulling Dr. Jones pant, ran little distance and again do the same thing. Dr. Jones went behind and followed the little dog and it stood under a tree, where Dr. Jones saw another dog who had broken its leg, crying and asking for help with full of tears.

Dr. Stanly Jones said, "A dog who could not speak won another dog who had broken its leg and brought to him for getting speedy recovery from the illness. How about men and women who can speak very well but not winning souls." How about You?
